Who can participate

Children and young people up to 24 years who attend a school or club located in the Manning Valley.

When to get involved

Projects should begin no earlier than Saturday 23rd November and should be completed by Saturday 30th November.

How to win the challenge

Complete and return the registration form by Friday 15th November.
Keep a photographic record of your project including before, during and after shots.
Submit your portfolio of photos to Greater Taree City Council by Friday 13th December.
The winning project will be judged on participation and overall project impact.

What can the prize money be spent on?

The winning school or club will be awarded \$1000 to be expended on further improvements to their school or club.
